OBTAIN THE FOLLOWING TOOLS:

- Razor blade
- Small Sanding block
- Square squeegee

- Lint-Free Cloth

I Quarter Windows Prep

Tools Required:

- Razor blade
- Small Sanding block

Materials Required:

- 3M Adhesion Promoter (00-9006-C15620*)
- 80-Grit Sand Paper
- Wax and Grease Remover
- Lint-Free Cloth

Order of operations:

1. Sand all bonding surfaces with 80-grit sand paper. (Figure 1)
2. Wipe all bonding surfaces with wax and grease remover. (Figure 2)
3. Apply 3M adhesion promoter to all bonding surfaces. (Figure 3)



Apply 3M adhesion promoter to all bonding surfaces



4. Apply double-sided tape to all bonding surfaces. (Figure 4).
5. Apply the black-out decal to the outside painted surface as shown in Figure 5.



II Quarter Windows Install

Materials Required:

- 3M Adhesion Promoter (00-9006-C15620*)
- Wax and Grease Remover
- Lint-Free Cloth

1. Wipe the entire quarter window with wax and grease remover. (Figure 1)
2. Apply 3M adhesion promoter to the bonding surface of the glass (the area of the glass in which the panel tape will contact). See Figure 2.
3. Remove the self-adhesive backing from the double-sided tape. (Figure 3)

4. Install the quarter window panel as follows:
- a. First: rest the three panel tabs along the top of the glass (Figure 4).
 - b. Second: Rotate the panel down and firmly press it onto the face of the glass so the glass is centered within all panel tabs. (Figures 4 and 5)

Install panel:

Second: Rotate the panel down and firmly press it onto the face of the glass so the glass is centered within all panel tabs



III Interior Quarter Window Decal Application

Tools Required:

- Square squeegee

Materials Required:

- Wax and Grease Remover

1. Clean the inside of each rear quarter window with glass cleaner.
2. Wet the surface of the window with a soapy water solution.
3. Remove the backing from the quarter window decal (06-9101-C14498B or 06-9101-C14499B) and wet with soapy water.
4. Starting on the small end of the decal, apply one corner to the window, then rub the decal into place with smooth, firm, vertical strokes.
 - There must be no bubbles of any size
5. Leave the decal to dry for at least 2 hours before removing the front cover to ensure the bond is set.
