



SALEEN DECAL PLACEMENT

materials needed:
spray cleaner (for example, Windex)
flat, smooth squeegee
lint-free dry cloth

1. Using a mild cleaner or soap and water solution, remove all traces of dirt, dust, or oil from the surface you will be applying the decal to. Wipe dry with a cloth.
2. Form a lubricating layer between the surface and the decal by spraying a moderate amount of cleaner onto the surface. This will allow you to line up the decal by sliding it into the correct position and is recommended for any size placement.
3. Peel the backing from the decal so that only the sticky part is exposed. Leave the decal-side paper in place as it will protect the decal during application.
4. Holding the decal flat, place it against the surface of the car. Using the body lines to judge by, slide the decal into position and apply light pressure to adhere it into place.
5. Run the squeegee over the protective paper in order to remove any excess liquid from under the decal. Use this time to work out any air bubbles that might have developed under the decal.
6. Let the decal set in place for several hours until the cleaning solution has dried and allowed the adhesive material to bond to the surface. Only after everything has dried should you remove the protective paper.
